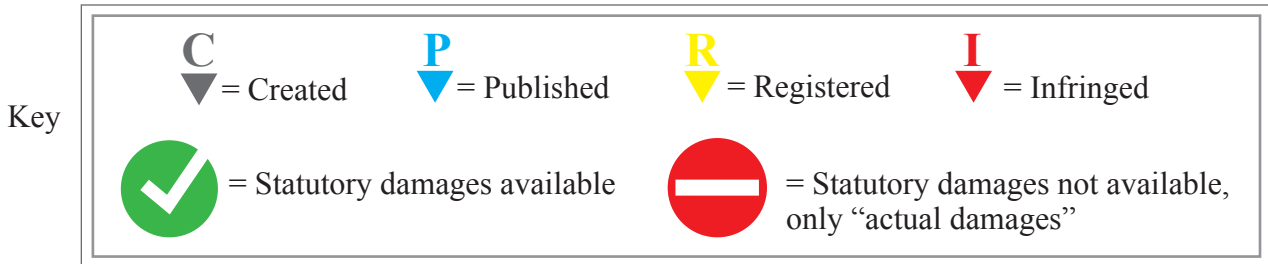


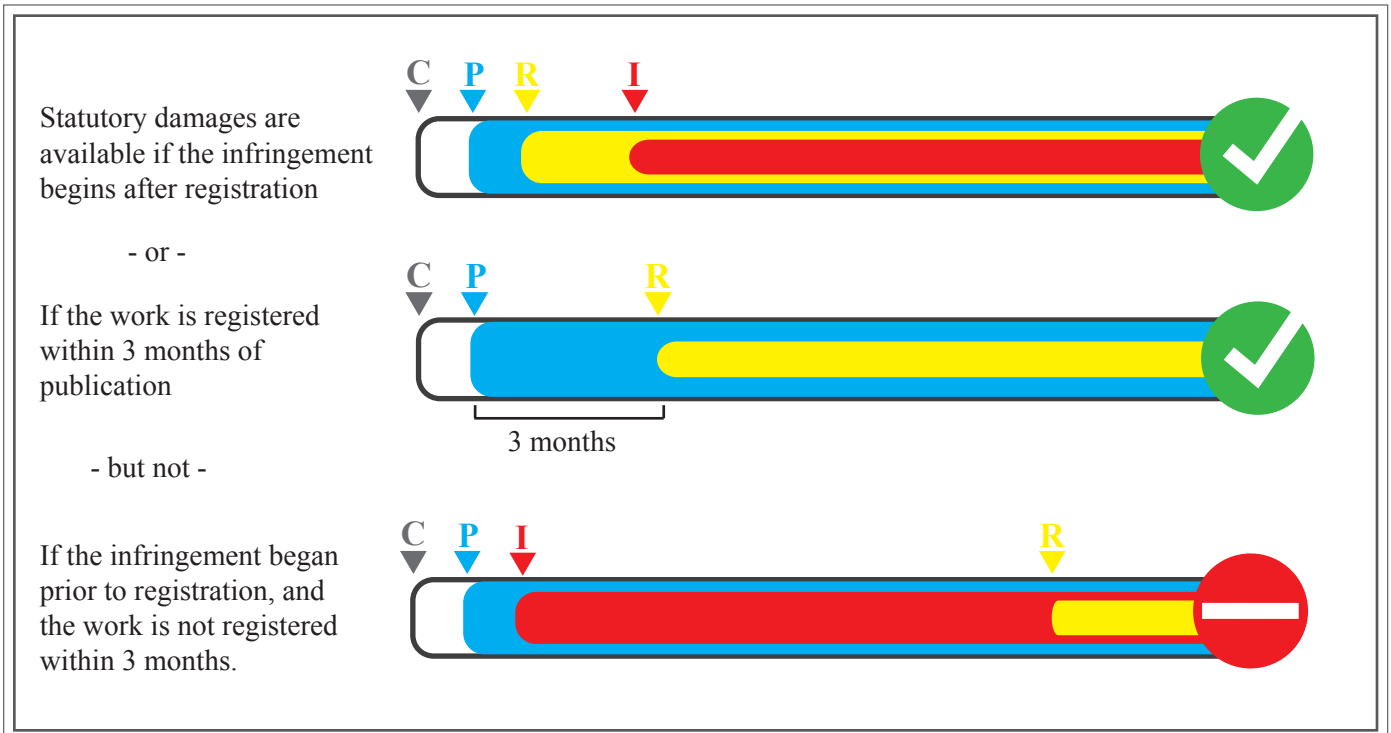
Visualizing Statutory Damages for Copyright Infringement.

Under certain circumstances, copyright owners are eligible to receive “statutory damages” for infringement of their copyrighted works. The Copyright Act provides a range of statutory damages of \$200 to \$150,000 per infringed work.

Under what circumstances are such damages available? The answer depends primarily on the timeline of events: when and if the work was **published**, when the work was **registered** with the Copyright Office, and when the **infringement** began. The following visualizations demonstrate this interplay.
